Eastern Counties Regional Library (ECRL) provides access to its Internet services for your convenience, and the public is permitted to use the service only as described in this policy.

When you access and/or use the Internet at an ECRL location, you agree to follow these terms of use:

- you are fully responsible for your actions
- your usage will be lawful and respect the rights and interests of others
- you are aware that your information is not encrypted (protected)
- you are using the service at your own risk

ECRL may change these Terms of Use at any time without notifying you, so users should review them each time you use the Internet service. Continued use of the service indicates acceptance of the modified terms.

As with other library materials and services, supervision of a child's access to the Internet is the responsibility of the parent/legal guardian.

If you ignore or breach these Terms of Use, ECRL has the right to end your access to the Internet service and contact law enforcement if appropriate.
