

Internet Use Policy

Eastern Counties Regional Library (ECRL) provides public access to the internet for free at all library branches. Users can access the internet either by using our WiFi or a public computer. All individuals who access an ECRL internet connection are permitted to use the service only as described in this policy.

When the public uses ECRL's free internet access all users agree to follow these terms of use:

- you are fully responsible for your actions
- your usage will be lawful and respect the rights and interests of others
- you are aware that your information is not encrypted (protected)
- you are using the service at your own risk

ECRL may change these Terms of Use at any time without notifying users, so all individuals should review them each time they access an ECRL internet connection. Continued use of ECRL internet connection(s) indicates acceptance of the modified terms of use.

As with other library materials and services, supervision of a child's access to the Internet is the responsibility of the parent/legal guardian.

If you ignore or breach these Terms of Use, ECRL has the right to end your access to Internet services and contact law enforcement if appropriate.
