

Requesting Users to Leave or Barring Future Use Policy

All library users observing proper conduct in the library are allowed to freely make use of the library. Those whose conduct is disruptive to Eastern Counties Regional Library (ECRL) operations and other users' use of the library may have the privilege of using the library limited or denied to the extent necessary to deal with the problem.

Users indulging in improper conduct may be asked to cease that conduct, to move to another location or activity, or to leave the library. Severe or recurring violations of the Library Use Policy may result in the individual(s) involved being barred from any use of the library and all ECRL locations and if necessary, this process may include requesting police intervention.

For dealings with conduct of youth, see the Youth Conduct and Safety in the Library Policy.
