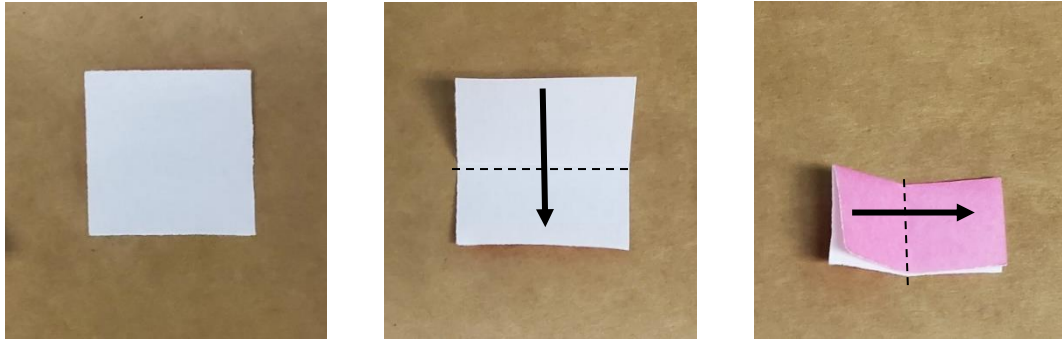


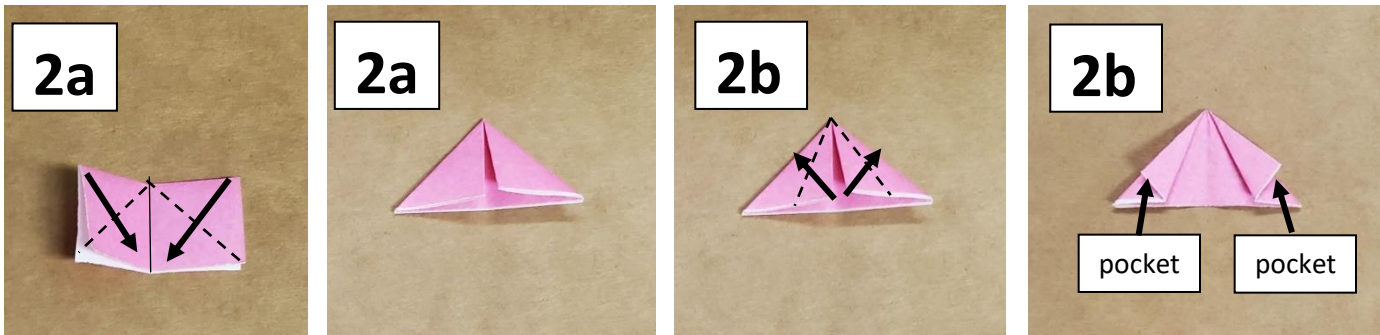
# Origami Fish Instructions

1. Fold square in half horizontally. Next, fold it in half vertically (like a book) to create a crease line, then unfold it.

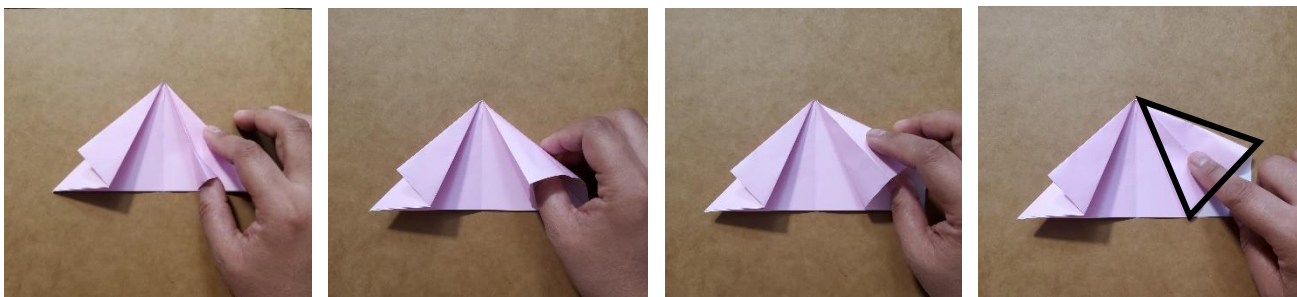


2a. Take the top left corner and fold it diagonally to the bottom centre, then fold the right side down the same way. It should look like a tent.

2b. Fold each flap out so that the straight edges align with the outer edges of the triangle. It will look like the tent flaps are open. Then unfold the flaps again. Note the bottoms of the triangles are pockets.

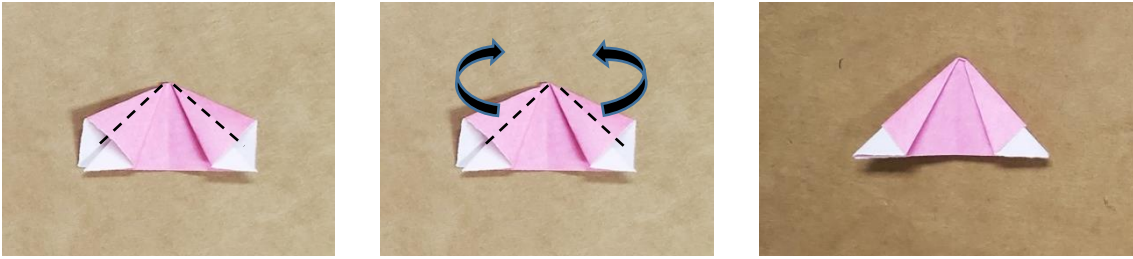


3. Use your thumb or pointer finger to open the pocket of the right triangle, pushing the back of the triangle outwards. Flatten the pocket along the crease lines you created in step 2. This should form a new triangle. Do the same to the left side.

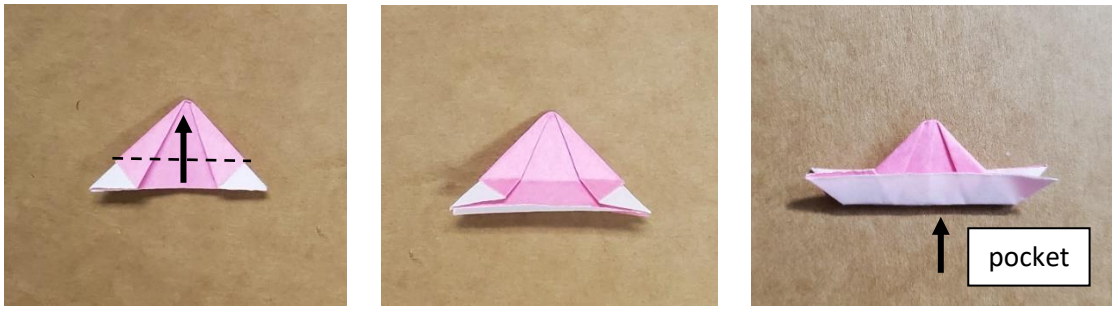

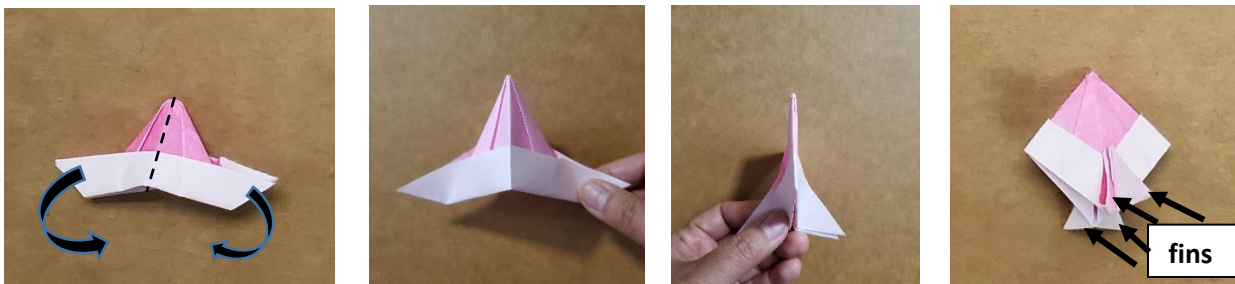
4. Fold the top half of each triangle backwards along the crease line in the centre of the triangle. Note the tiny triangles on each side at the bottom.



5. Fold one bottom edge up to make a horizontal crease line between the tips of the tiny triangles. Flip the paper over and fold up the other bottom edge the same way. It should look like a sailboat. Note the bottom pocket.



6. Pinch each end of the boat together at the bottom and push the ends toward each other so that the paper folds along the vertical crease lines in the middle. It should make a diamond shape with the parts you were holding (the "fins") sticking out at the bottom.



7. Open the fins on each side and flatten them. Rotate your fish to the side, and it is complete
